



FRONTIER FARM CREDIT - RETAIL OFFICES

Located across Kansas, these lending offices reflect their rural surroundings, built and natural. The steep metal roofs and simple forms recall the lines of farmsteads and barns. Locally quarried limestone projects an image of permanence. Red and green glazed brick accents mimic the seasonal colors of fields.

To keep a consistent look between the five offices, we offered the client prototype designs ranging in size from 6,900 to 9,200 square feet, which we then customized to fit each location. Floor plans are organized into two parts - one with closed and open work workstations, the other for support functions. Generous amounts of glass showcase the rural landscape.

Over the course of six years, we completed new facilities in Baldwin City, Manhattan, Marysville, Parsons, and Hiawatha, Kansas, as well as the facility for the Frontier Farm Credit Corporate Headquarters in Manhattan. We continue to work with FFC to update and renovate their facilities to meet current needs.
