



LINCOLN CHRISTIAN SCHOOL IMPROVEMENTS

The Clark Enersen Partners was hired to develop a long-term vision for Lincoln Christian School through the completion of a Master Plan. We also developed a program statement and design for a Science and Technology Addition and new Joan Robinson Amphitheater, with construction completed for both in 2016.

The Master Plan, completed in 2013, identifies five phases beginning with the Science and Technology Addition. Future phases include renovations to the high school, elementary school, gymnasium and commons, as well as additions to accommodate fine arts, a chapel, gymnasium, administrative offices, high school classrooms, a weight room, locker rooms, kitchen, and pre-k classrooms. We also identified a three-phase parking expansion to accommodate 550 cars.

Our recent past work at Lincoln Christian includes HVAC upgrades to the gymnasium, cafeteria, and elementary school. We also made significant improvements to their site including a new outdoor learning classroom and the expansion of athletic practice fields.
