



MISSOURI STATE UNIVERSITY - PINEGAR ARENA

The William H. Darr Agricultural Center, located on the campus of Missouri State University, is a 125-acre farm that provides practical, hands-on agricultural experience for college students. The Center includes Pinegar Arena to aid in the research of horses, cattle, forestry and agronomy and supports the many and diverse programs offered by the University's Department of Agriculture. The renovation and new addition provide enhanced educational opportunities for the University's School of Agricultural Sciences. The project included the complete renovation of the arena including the addition of 18 horse stalls, equine and bovine handling facilities, research laboratories, classrooms, and offices. Improvements made to the 35,220-square-foot arena allow the University to host events sponsored by the School of Agricultural Sciences.
